

## **Admissions Criteria into Years 10, 11 & 12**

The Board of Governors delegate responsibility, to the Senior Management Team of the school, for the application of Admissions Criteria into Years 10, 11 and 12.

Owing to the difficulty in changing GCSE courses when moving school, only in exceptional circumstances will an application for a place in Y11 (other than at the start of the academic year) or Y12 be considered.

If a place becomes available in Y10-12 the following procedure will be followed:

The applicant must on application provide evidence (two most recent school reports) of satisfactory attainment, attitude and behaviour that would indicate they would benefit from a place at this school.

The applicant may also be asked to sit a standardised entrance test set by the school.

It is the responsibility of the Senior Management Team to decide if, on the basis of the evidence made available, a place is to be offered.

A waiting list will be maintained for each academic year and this will be updated annually. If a pupil's name is to remain on the list an application will need to be re-submitted each new academic year.
