

Year 12 Report Summary 2016

Although the January report offers detailed information on progress the final attainment grade is not a prediction of GCSE performance. Subject marks that contain a Controlled Assessment element are provisional and subject to internal standardisation and CCEA moderation.

Subject	Report Description
Art	<p>The Year 12 Art and Design report mark is made up of 2 parts:</p> <p>Part 1 The coursework portfolio (60%) This is the completed coursework portfolio from Year 11 and to date in Year 12 including final outcome.</p> <p>Part 2 First sheet of exam project that was released on January 7th (40%). First sheet of exam project is completed in exam time.</p>
Biology	<p>This report is based upon an assessment of all-content covered to date, approximately 75% of the full GCSE course. The GCSE Controlled Assessment has NOT been included - this contributes 25% of the final GCSE grade.</p>
Business Studies	<p>This report is based on an assessment of all course content covered to date. The GCSE controlled assessment has been included, representing 25% of the final mark.</p>
Chemistry	<p>This report is based on the assessment of the complete Unit 1 and approximately 40% of Unit 2. No Controlled Assessment marks have been included.</p>
English Language	<p>This report is based on all work covered to date. 20% of the mark comes from the assessment of Speaking and Listening.</p> <p>A further 40% of the mark comes from two of the three Controlled Assessment essays (Creative Writing and Analysis of the Spoken Word).</p> <p>The controlled Assessment on the written word does not form part of this mark.</p>

English Literature	<p>75% of this mark is based on assessment of the novel, unseen poetry and paired poetry. The set drama text has not been assessed for the mock examination.</p> <p>25% of the mark comes from Controlled Assessment essays (Shakespeare and Heritage Prose).</p>
Geography	<p>This report is based on an assessment of all-content covered to date, approximately 75% of the full GCSE course.</p> <p>The GCSE Controlled Assessment has been included, representing 25% of the final mark.</p>
History	<p>The History report is based on an assessment of all content covered in class to date, which is worth 75% of the full GCSE course.</p> <p>The GCSE controlled assessment has not been included as it was only completed during the examinations and this is worth 25% of the GCSE course.</p>
Home Economics	<p>This report is based on an assessment of all subject specification covered to date which is approximately 80% of the full GCSE course. Controlled assessment is ongoing and therefore has not been included in the final mark.</p>
ICT	<p>This report is based on content covered to date, excluding Unit1 that was externally awarded a mark by CCEA in August 2013.</p> <p>The website controlled assessment task mark has been included, representing 40% of the final report mark.</p>
Journalism	<p>This mark covers all Controlled Assessment (60%) and examination work (40%) covered to date.</p>
LLW	<p>This report mark represents 3/5 of the total LLW GCSE and contains both controlled assessments (60%).</p>

Mathematics	<p>M1-M3 Classes This report is based on an assessment of all-content covered to date. It contains a mixture of questions from modules T4 and T6. There is no GCSE controlled assessment for this subject.</p> <p>M4 This report is based on an assessment of all-content covered to date. It contains a mixture of questions from modules T3 and T6. There is no GCSE controlled assessment for this subject.</p>
Mathematics (Further)	This report is based on an assessment of all-content covered to date, it contains a mixture of Pure Mathematics, Statistics and Mechanics questions.
Modern Languages	<p>This report is based on one Controlled Assessment Speaking task (30%), a Higher level Listening Comprehension examination paper (20%), a Higher level Reading Comprehension examination paper (20%) and one Controlled Assessment Writing task (30%). This is the weighting applied at GCSE.</p> <p>Two Controlled Assessment Speaking tasks and two Controlled Assessment Writing tasks will be submitted for the actual GCSE.</p> <p>The Speaking task is subject to moderation by CCEA. Both Writing tasks are marked by CCEA.</p>
Moving Image Arts	The January Assessment includes 3 components: 20% Unit 1 Controlled Assessment grade achieved in Year 11, 40% Critical Response January Mock Examination and 40% Unit 2 Controlled Assessment: Thinking Statement and Visual Studies.
Music	The January assessment consists of 70%. The paper forms 35% and the performance exam accounts for the final 35%. Controlled assessment accounts for 30% and has not been included in this result.
PE	This report is based on an exam mark worth 40% and practical mark of 60%. In June the exam mark will be worth 40%, practical mark 40% and coursework 20%.

Physics	This report is based on an assessment of all-content covered to date, approximately 80% of the full GCSE course. The GCSE controlled Assessment has not been included.
RS	This report is based on one examination result of all content covered in both Year 11 and 12 Short Course GCSE Religious Studies (Ethics) to date. There is no Controlled Assessment within GCSE Religious Studies.
