



How the A* is awarded at A-level by Subject.

Art

A* must achieve 320 marks overall. Must achieve an aggregate of at least 90% of uniform marks across 2 A2 units (180+ marks).

Biology

Candidates must achieve an overall grade A and an aggregate of at least 90% across the 3 A2 units.

Business Studies

Either both A2 modules over 90% or total for A21 and A22 added together, divided by 200 and multiplied by 100.

Chemistry

Candidates should gain grade A on the A level overall - 80% on the uniform Mark scale and who also achieve at least 90% on the A2 units.

English Literature

Pupils must have gained an A grade in the full A level and an A* on aggregate in A2 modules (over 90%).

Geography

The student must average over 80% overall and over 90% in the A2 modules.

Health and Social Care

A grade 'A' overall at A Level, and 90% or more of the uniform mark scale across A2 units

History & Politics

90% above at A2 in both modules.

Home Economics

Gain an A overall at A level and gain 90% or more of the maximum uniform marks on combined totals of the A2 units

ICT

An A* is awarded to candidates who attain:

- an overall grade A in the qualification; and
- an aggregate of at least 90% of the uniform marks across the A2 units.

Mathematics

Students must obtain an aggregate of at least 180% in the C3 and C4 A2 modules

MIA

A candidate should achieve an A Grade with 90% in both A2 Modules.

Modern Languages

Average of 90%+ in both units.

Music

90% plus marks overall.

PE

A2 UMS Mark of 400.

Physics

Candidates should gain 80% average across AS/A2 and gain 90% or more of the maximum uniform marks on combined totals of the A2 units.

Religious Studies

Candidates should to gain an A grade overall at A level and gain 90% or more of the maximum uniform marks on combined totals of the A2 units.

Technology

The student must average over 80% overall and over 90% in the A2 modules.
