### **Coursework (CW)**

### **Controlled Assessment (CA)**

Controlled assessment is a new approach for those subjects that require internal assessment.

It is a tightening of the circumstances in which candidates, over a period of time, complete those aspects of the subject that are usually marked by their teacher.
